

GCYL Playoff Overtime Procedure

In the event of a tie score at the end of regulation, the tie will be broken with the Overtime Procedure below:

- After a one minute break, one coach and one captain will report to midfield for the coin flip and overtime instructions from the referees.
- Visiting Team will call coin flip to begin overtime. There will be only one coin flip in overtime.
- Winner has choice of OFFENSE, DEFENSE, or END OF FIELD TO PLAY AT. If tied after 1st overtime, loser of coin flip now has the choices. This will continue to alternate at the end of each overtime period if score is still tied.
- 1st and 2nd Overtime Periods will begin at the 10 yard line. All subsequent overtimes will begin at the 10 yard line also.
- Each team will have 4 downs to score a touchdown or field goal. Extra points will be tried.
- Both teams will play at same end of field.
- Each team will be permitted one timeout per overtime period. UNUSED TIMEOUTS FROM REGULATION AND PREVIOUS OVERTIME PERIODS WILL NOT CARRY OVER.
- Once any change of possession occurs, the ball is immediately dead and the series is over. The defense cannot score a touchdown.
